

# Hebraic Theological Misconceptions

## Does “Jesus” mean “Hail Zeus”?

- Yeshua: (with vowel indicators יֵשׁוּעַ ) (without vowel indicators ישׁע)
- Iesous/Jesus: (dʒiːzəs or Ἰησοῦς)
- Zeus: (Ζεὺς Δίας or Días)
- Hail Zeus: Χαλάζι Δία

Conclusion: Jesus is not even close to Hail Zeus as the talking point indicates, the name Jesus is nothing more than a bad translation

## Eliseus Means my “El is Zeus”

- My God: (in greek) Θεέ μου
- Zeus: Zeus: (Ζεὺς Δίας or Días)
- (Pron.: /iˈlaɪzə/;[1] Hebrew אֱלִישָׁע, Modern *Elisha Tiberian* ʔĕlîšāˁ; "My God is salvation", Greek: Ἐλισσαῖος, *Elissaios* or Ἐλισαίε, *Elisaié*, Arabic: اليَسَعَ *Elyasa*)

## LORD means the Deity Baal

- Ba'al (or Baal) in (Hebrew בעל) meaning Lord of Husband
- "Husband" in Hebrew is *ba'al*, pronounced *BA-al*. The more common word is "ishi" - Baali can mean husband but has a different connotation. It carries the idea of lord and submission while "ishi" carries the idea of kindness, protection and mutual love.
- “Ba’alat” or “Ba`alah,” only the context of a text can indicate of which Ba’al 'lord' or Ba’alath 'Lady' a particular inscription or text is speaking.
- 1 Kings 18:21-40 uses בעלה and not בעל

Obviously not the same thing, yet it is often told it is.

## **We Are Under The New Covenant (Which is the Same As The Old)**

31 (30) Behold the days come, says YHWH, that I will make a renewed covenant with the House of Yisra'el, and with the House of Y'hudah.

32 (31) Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers, in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt: forasmuch as they broke My covenant, although I was a husband over them, says YHWH.

33 (32) But this is the covenant that I will make with the House of Yisra'el after those Days, says YHWH: I will put My Torah in their inward parts, and in their heart ... will I write it. And I will be their Elohim, and they shall be My people.

**(Jeremiah 31:31-32)**

12 Therefore prophesy, and say unto them, Thus says the Adonai YHWH: Behold, I will open your graves, and cause you to come up out of your graves, O My people: and I will bring you into the land of Yisra'el.

13 And you shall know that I am YHWH, when I have opened your graves and caused you to come up out of your graves, O My people.

14 And I will put My spirit in you, and you shall live. And I will place you in your own land, and you shall know that I YHWH have spoken, and performed it, says YHWH.

15 And the word of YHWH came unto me, saying:

16 And you, son of man, take you one stick, and write upon it: For Y'hudah, and for the children of Yisra'el his companions. Then take another stick, and write upon it: For Yosef, the stick of Efrayim, and of all the House of Yisra'el, his companions.

17 And join them for you, one to another into one stick, that they may become one, in your hand.

18 And when the children of your people shall speak unto you, saying, Will you not tell us what you mean by these?

19 Say unto them, Thus says the Adonai YHWH: Behold, I will take the stick of Yosef, which is in the hand of Efrayim, and the tribes of Yisra'el his companions, and, I will put them unto him, together with the stick of Y'hudah: and make them one stick ... and they shall be one, in My hand.

20 And the sticks whereon you write, shall be in your hand before their eyes.
